ATTENTION: LEGISLATIVE CHAIRMAN AND YOU SHOULD KEEP A COPY FOR YOUR COMMANDER'S BOOK.

Be sure you know what House District, Senate District and Congressional District you live in. Boundaries have changed due to recent census.

Write a letter to each of the above and make a short introduction of who you are: name, title, Post number and Post address.

Outline some of the programs your Post is actively involved in. Ask for the opportunity to meet with them. Invite them to a Post meeting or a Post function.

Ask to be put on their mailing list to keep you informed of any Legislation that involves Veterans and their entitlements.

ALSO CONTACT YOUR MAYOR AND TOWN BOARD

CHAIRMAN - they need to know what your Post is doing for the community. Invite them to Post functions.

Be sure and have articles printed in your local newspapers that will let the community know all the good things the V.F.W. does.
